27th March 2023: Mr. Ravi Rebbapragada, Executive Director and team Samata met the collector, ASR dist for obtaining permission for carrying out counselling programme in schools and colleges in ASR district.



On 10th March, 2023, Around 37 tribal senior citizens including women, minor girls, boys and workers from Odisha's Balangir dist were trafficked to ABC brick kiln at Gourreddipeta village in Peddapalli Mandal of Peddapalli dist of Telangana. Despite working hard for near about 4 months, they were assaulted, exploited, abused and held captive by the ABC brick kiln owner, Mr. G Babu.

After the petition was sent out to the line department including the collector and Commissionerate of police, Ramagundam and continuous coordination with the dist administration from SAMATA, The labor department along with DCPO, Peddapalli and Tehsildar raided the brick kiln and rescued the children all the workers including children and sent them back to their native place on 10th March 2023..



On 20th March, 2023, Based on a petition sent out to the authorities by Samata requesting for rescue of child labourers and bonded labourers on instructions of ADGP CID, CID MBNR DSP Shankar, Krishna SI, MRO, Asst. Labour officer and Odisha liaison officer rescued 48 Labours including 12 children from ARB brick kiln, Krishna, Narayanpet district of Telangana and sent them back to their native home..



On **20th March, 2023**, Based on a petition along with testimonials from workers and children requesting the concerned authorities to rescue, a joint rescue operation was carried out by DCPO, Asst. Labour officer, Tehsildar and SI, Agripalli at GRB brick kiln at Adavinekkalam village in Agripalli mandal of Eluru dist of Andhra Pradesh and rescued 17 bonded labourers and 4 child labourers and sent them back to their native home.



On **23rd March, 2023**, After Samata provided information and testimonies from women and children and alerted ADG CID, Telangana, CID team along with the Asst. labour officer and Child Protection officer rushed and rescued 13 bonded labourers including 4 child labourers belonging to Adivasi and Dalit communities, who were allegedly trafficked from Odisha to work at TRP brick kiln at Potharam village in Malial mandal of Jagtial dist of Telangana and sent them back to their native place.
