On 14th May 2023: Based on a complaint made by Samata regarding the bonded labourers including children who were held captive by MML brick kiln at Kothapet village of Shivampet mandal of Medak dist of Telangana were rescued by the district police along with revenue, labour and child welfare and women department on the instruction of ADG of CID, Telangana.



On 10th May 2023: Based on a complaint made by Samata regarding the abuse, exploitation, and held captive of bonded workers including children belonging to the Adivavsis and Dalit from Balangir dist of Odisha by the SMB brick kiln at Donabanda village of Mylavaram mandal of NTR dist of Andhra Pradesh.



50 Children Among 167 Odisha Migrant Labourers Rescued From Telangana Brick Kiln:

On 08th May 2023: Based on a complaint made SAMATA, on the instruction of ADG, CID, Telangana, Yadadri Bhuvangiri dist police along with revenue and labour department and CID RO Nalgonda has rescued as many as167 bonded labourers including 50 children and 47 women, who were engaged at RRR brick kiln at Jagatpalli in Telengana's Pochampalli areas and sent them back to their native place. However, none of them provided release certificate nor were they given any compensation amount.
