## State Directorates / Departments of Mines and Geology

The state departments of mines and geology or in several states called as Directorate of Mines and Geology are entrusted with the functions pertaining to assessments, management and awarding of mineral concessions at the state level. These departments are the nodal points at each state and manage information at the state level. In case of certain minerals, these departments have to take prior approval of the Central Government i.e. Ministry of Mines before granting a mineral concession.
